3. Changes in the Service Pack

The key changes are as follows:

- * Supported Adobe(R) Acrobat(R) 9 and Adobe(R) Reader(R) 9.
 - Corrected a problem that even if the "When inserting pages from password-protected and printing restricted PDF files, attach source files

instead of showing actual contents" checkbox is selected in viewer settings of Rack2-Viewer, the setting becomes invalid for some of the PDF files created with Adobe(R) Acrobat(R) 9.

- Corrected a problem that changes made in a inserted source PDF file with Adobe(R) Acrobat(R) 9 will not be included in the pages of Rack2-Viewer.
- * In order to avoid mistakes of specifying a folder which is already specified as the LibRoot folder, changed that the specified LibRoot folder can be recognized by a Rack2-Filer icon.
- * Enhanced the accuracy for creating key text blocks, when importing data from ScanSnap.
- * Corrected a problem that the result of key text blocks differs between Rack2-Viewer and Rack2-WorkArea.
- * Corrected a problem that the Rack2-Viewer window is not displayed properly, when using the dual display environment with different resolutions.
- * Corrected a problem that fails to affix stamps from right-click menu, when using Rack2-Viewer in full screen window mode.
- * Corrected a problem that the Rack2-Viewer window is not displayed properly, when the window is in full screen and rotate mode.
- * Corrected a problem that the displayed order of thumbnails is incorrect, when viewing the thumbnails on the divider sheet of Rack2-Viewer.
- * Corrected a problem that printing is performed for squares of specified copies, when printing with Rack2-Viewer in a Windows Vista(R) environment.
- * Corrected a problem that a PowerPoint file being edited will be imported, when editing the file while importing another PowerPoint file.
- * Corrected a problem that even if the "When inserting pages from password-protected and printing restricted PDF files, attach source files instead of showing actual contents" checkbox is selected in viewer settings of Rack2-Viewer, some of the PDF files whose password or printing restriction is set by Adobe(R) Acrobat(R) 8 cannot be imported as specified.
- * Corrected a problem that a message indicating an error in "Makethum.exe" may appear, when scanning a large amount of documents using a scanner with TWAIN driver.
- * Corrected a problem which occurs when a network is disconnected while launching a binder on the network in read-only mode.
- * Corrected a problem which occurs when a LibRoot folder is set on a network without network authentication.
- * Corrected a problem that data can be moved between a normal binder and card binder.
- * Changed the action for clicking the hyperlinks on Rack2-Viewer. It was changed to display the contents of a hyperlink with the browser specified as the "default browser", instead of displaying with Windows(R) Internet Explorer(R).
- * Corrected a problem that black and white are inverted in some of the PDF files, when importing files.
- * Corrected a problem that a margin will be inserted in the center of facing pages, when importing an over-sized data, by splitting it into two pages.
- * Corrected a problem that Rack2-Filer shuts down, when importing binders with long path name.
- * Corrected a problem that Rack2-Viewer does not respond, when saving a binder with 1000 pages of key text blocks created.
- * Corrected a problem that Rack2-Viewer does not respond, when creating key text blocks for a binder with 1000 pages.
- * Corrected a problem that file import may fail, when importing JPEG files other than full color files.
- * The following changes are made for "Rack2-Filer Backup & Restore Tool".
 - Corrected a problem in calculation of disk volume when restoring the data. (There were a few cases where restoration failed due to disk shortage.)

- Corrected a problem that backup or restoration cannot be performed, when specifying a drive letter assigned network folder as a backup folder.

* Some of other minor problems have been corrected or improved.

4. Cautions for Use

* When setting a link folder in the network folder and sharing the data, the font specified as the binder title may not be displayed correctly if the client computer does not have the required font.

* For Windows VISTA DPI Scaling, if a scale other than the Default Scale (96DPI) is set, it may not be shown on the screen.
Make sure that DPI Scaling is set to Default Scale (96DPI).

* Do not log off or shutdown while an operation is being processed in the work area.

* Environment dependant characters (unicode) are not supported.
Do not use environment dependant characters (unicode) for the installation folder, user names, folder names, and other string variables.
